Dress Code

Please make sure you are familiar with and abide by the Club's dress code outlined below. Visitors not complying with the dress code may be asked to leave the Course.

DRESS RULES

A neat and tidy standard of dress is required on the course and in the clubhouse at all times.

Members or visitors not complying with the dress code may be asked to leave the premises.

ACCEPTABLE

- ✓ Collared T-Shirts must be worn.
- ✓ Tailored style shorts, Trousers, and Skirts.
- ✓ Socks must be worn and can be long, Ankle or trainer length.
- ✓ Jerseys, Jumpers, Vests and Jackets that are Suitable for golf wear.
- ✓ Golf Shoes with soft spikes, Normal sport shoes that will not Cause indentations to greens.



UNACCEPTABLE

- T-Shirt without collars, singlet tops, cropped or tank tops, or anything that might be considered offensive or untidy.
- ➤ Brief short, Beach shorts, Tracksuits / pants and tights.
- > Street shoes, Sandals, no shoes & no socks.
- ➤ Sport shoes with studs or deep sole contours that can Leave indentations on greens.
